

Accessing Park House

Park House, 40 Edgbaston Park Road, Edgbaston, Birmingham, B15 2RT

Our Park House meetings will either be in the Courtyard Room in the brick buildings to the left of the main house (just visible in the photo below), or in the Garden Room in the main house, pictured below:



Park House, itself, is not visible from Edgbaston Park Road, but you can look out for the signs and the gatehouse pictured below:



On the University campus map at <https://www.birmingham.ac.uk/visit/maps-and-directions.aspx>, Park House is building G19 in the Green Zone.

Buses

The 98 and X64 bus stops are approximately 5-10 mins walk in both directions from the entrance. Unfortunately, there is no pavement on the Park House side of the road, between these bus stops and the house.

Trains

Parking

There is a Pay and Display car park down the drive to the house. Charges are at least £3. There are two spaces reserved for Blue Badge holders by the front door to the main house.
