

## Access to Suresearch Meetings in Muirhead Tower

**Muirhead Tower, Edgbaston Campus, University of Birmingham, Edgbaston, Birmingham, B15 2TT**

Suresearch Writers and Readers Group and Inpatient Care Forum meetings are generally held at Muirhead Tower.

### Special Note

There are substantial building and landscaping works going on around Muirhead Tower in 2017-2018, with signposted diversionary walking routes to the front of the Tower, and possible disruption to access routes to the building.

Changes are also being made to locations of car parks. You may want to check information provided here and on the websites, or allow extra time.

### Accessing Muirhead Tower

Muirhead Tower is a tall brutalist style concrete building on the Pritchatts Road side of the main Edgbaston campus. It is building R21 in the red zone on the University maps, which you can download at <https://www.birmingham.ac.uk/visit/maps-and-directions.aspx>



There is a flight of steps up to the main entrance, but there is a lift at the side of the building, which you can reach by walking to the left of the staircase.



Once you have reached the main foyer walk over to the “Lift Lobby”. You need to select which floor you want on the display before going to the lifts. This display will tell which lift to take.



The first digit of the room number for the meeting indicates which floor it is on. For example, room 431 is on the fourth floor.

## **Buses**

Bus services serving the University and QE Hospital changed on 22 July 2018. Information is available at: <https://nxbus.co.uk/west-midlands/>

The 1A, 61 and 63 buses run along Bristol Road, and the stops on the junction with Edgbaston Park Road are a 10-15 minute walk from Muirhead Tower.

The X20, X21, X22 buses stop on Pritchatts Road, just a few minutes away from the Tower.

## **Trains**

The University rail station is a 10-15 minute walk through the campus.

## **Information on Car Parking**

## **Accessibility**

There are lifts into and within the building, as described above.
