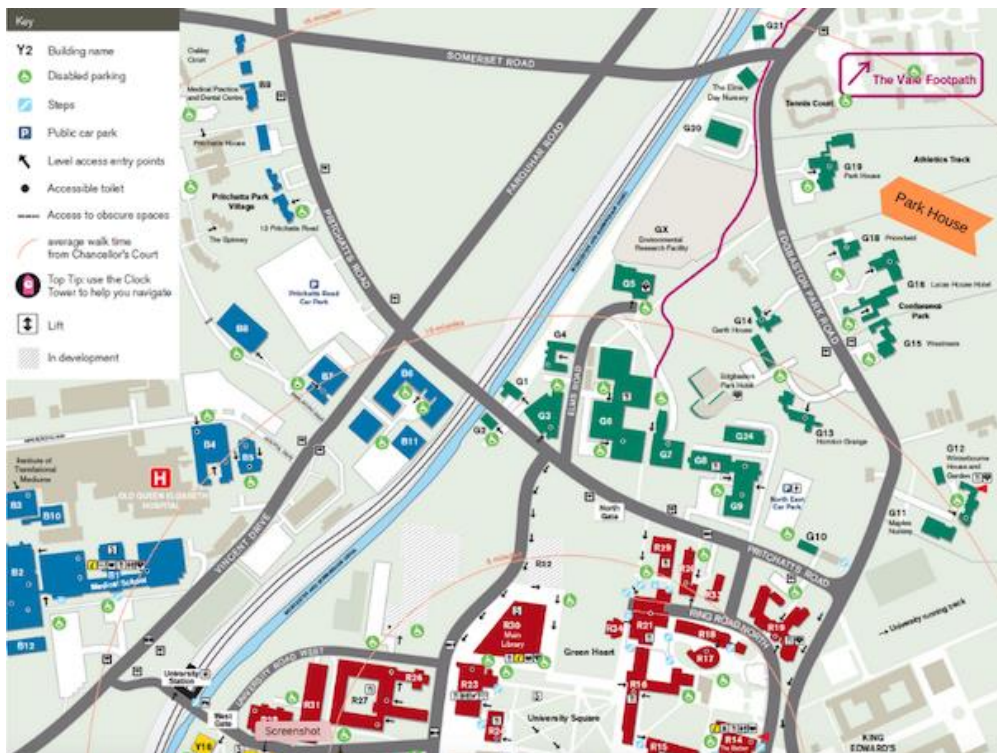


Accessing Park House



Park House, 40 Edgbaston Park Road, Edgbaston, Birmingham, B15 2RT

On the University campus map, Park House is building G19 in the Green Zone. Up to date electronic versions of campus maps can be viewed and downloaded at <https://www.birmingham.ac.uk/visit/maps-and-directions.aspx>

Park House, itself, is not visible from Edgbaston Park Road, but you can look out for the signs and the gatehouse pictured below:



Our Park House meetings will either be in the Courtyard Room in the brick buildings to the left of the main house (just visible in the photo below), or in the Garden Room in the main house, pictured below:



Buses

The X20, X21 and X22 bus stops on Edgbaston Park Road are approximately 5-10 mins walk in both directions from the entrance. These buses run from the City Centre, past the University and QE Hospital and on to parts of South West Birmingham. Unfortunately, there is no pavement on the Park House side of the road, between these bus stops and Park House.

Other services stopping a little further from Park House include Nos. 1,1A and 61.

Trains

The University Rail Station is a 10-20 minute walk from Park House, and walking routes are shown on the campus maps. The station is on the Lichfield - Birmingham New Street – Redditch line.

Parking

There is a Pay and Display car park down the drive to the house. Charges are at least £3. There are two spaces reserved for Blue Badge holders by the front door to the main house.

Accessibility

Blue badge holders can park in the two reserved spaces near the front door to the main house, or elsewhere in the parking areas to the house.
